Chitra Ganesh is a visual artist based in Brooklyn, NY. Her work has been widely exhibited in PS 1/MOMA, Brooklyn Museum, Goteborgs Konsthalle, Andy Warhol Museum, and Rubin Museum.

Shai Heredia is a filmmaker, curator, and founding director of Experimenta, an international moving image art biennial in India. Her award-winning short film, *I Am Micro* (2012), develops a longstanding interest in avant-garde film practice and the state of official archive.



Priya Sen is a Delhi-based filmmaker and artist working on questions of form, urban ethnographies, music, and migration. Her latest documentary, *Yeh Freedom Life / This Freedom Life* (2018) follows two working-class women in Ambedkar Nagar who try to create a "free" space for life and love.
